## Dottorato in Management for digital transformation: business, communication and ethics

For the proper management of the Ph.D. course in *Management for Digital Transformation: Business Communication and Ethics*, the main deadlines that both the Academic Board and the students are required to comply with are listed below:

### **for the Coordinator and the Academic Board:**

1. By the end of November of the new Ph.D. cycle, the Coordinator must convene the Academic Board for the presentation of the new Ph.D. students.
2. By the end of December of the new Ph.D. cycle, the Coordinator and the Academic Board must:
  - a) assign Supervisors to the new Ph.D. students;
  - b) evaluate the teaching and research activities of students from previous cycles for admission to the next year of the course.
3. By the end of January, the Academic Board must:
  - a) evaluate the theses of candidates completing the Ph.D. cycle and decide on their admission to the final defence;
  - b) designate the members of the evaluation committee for the candidates.
4. If the Coordinator deems it appropriate, by the end of June the Coordinator may convene a meeting of the Academic Board for a preliminary assessment of the activities carried out by the PhD students.

### **for the Ph.D. Students:**

1. With reference to point 2. listed above, the students must submit their report on the training and research activities carried out during the year at least 15 days before the date on which the Academic Board is convened. As a guideline, the document should be prepared by mid-November. The report must be sent to the Coordinator.
2. For students to be admitted to the final examination, the Board should receive the Supervisor's assessment of the thesis and the report on the training and research activities at least 30 days before the date on which the Academic Board is convened. As a guideline, the document should be prepared by the end of December. All documents must be sent to the Coordinator.
3. With reference to point 4. listed above, the students must submit their report on the training and research activities carried out during the year at least 15 days before the date on which the Academic Board is convened. As a guideline, the document should be prepared by the end of May. The report must be sent to the Coordinator.

For all other matters, the regulations of the PhD course shall apply.
